### Course Objective

#### Material Covered:

Students will participate in a consultative hematology service and in hematology clinics. A broad range of hematological problems are seen. In addition, there is a didactic component, with small group formal and informal lectures with the faculty. The topics covered include evaluation and pathophysiology of anemias, coagulopathies, thrombotic disorders, hemophilia, malignancies, bone marrow disorders and hemoglobinopathies.

#### Skills Acquired:

The student will participate in inpatient consults, outpatient clinics, teaching rounds and hematology conferences. He/she will learn the fundamentals of hematology and the elements of being an effective consultant. The student will participate at his/her level of responsibility.
