8:15 AM – Program begins

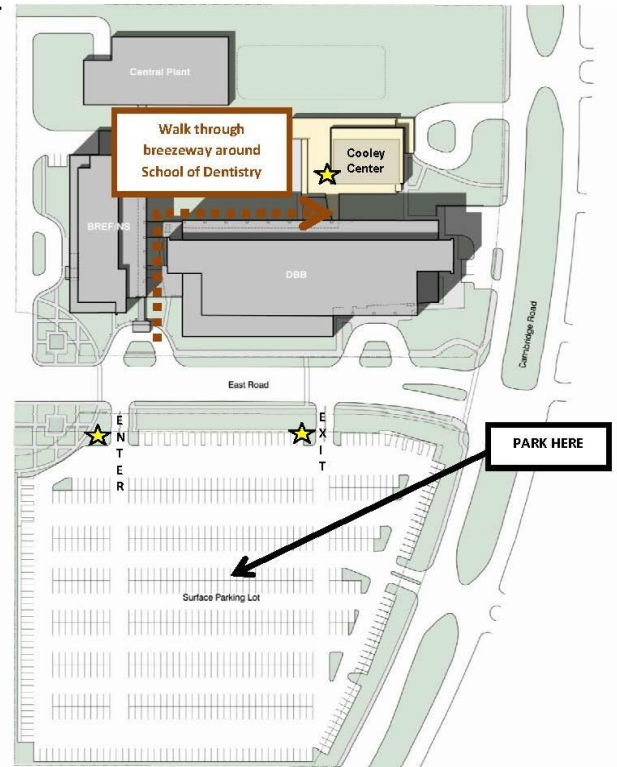
